Colossians 1.9-12 For this reason also, since the day we heard of it, we have not ceased to pray for you and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, so that you will walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, to please Him in all respects, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; strengthened with all power, according to His glorious might, for the attaining of all steadfastness and patience; joyously giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints in Light.

Essential Accountability Questions:

1. Has the centrality of Jesus been anchored in your heart and mind this morning with faith and deep resolved belief? (2 Cor 13.14, Psalm 50.23)
2. Have you been above reproach in words, actions and attitudes? (1 Thess 5.16-24, Philippians 2.15)
3. Are you walking in purity in regards to sexual sin? (Colossians 3.1-7)
 - a. Have you been with a member of the opposite sex or anyone anywhere this week that could have been seen as compromising?
 - b. Have you dwelled on or seen any material this week that is lustful or not above reproach? (cut out news feeds that have attached sensuality ads to them, etc)
 - c. Or have you let your eyes or heart drift without addressing it with Scripture, confession, repentance and replacement of worship? (Matt. 6:22-24)
4. How are your physical disciplines? (1 Timothy 4.8)
5. Have you been integrous with your finances (Luke 16.11-12)
6. How are your spiritual disciplines? (Matthew 5-7)
7. Have you honored and spent time with your spouse and the family in a way that they are adequately and fully loved and honored (Philippians 1:1-5)?
8. Are you being faithful in your work? (Colossians 3.23-24)
9. How are you doing in “things like these” (Galatians 5.16-24)
10. What are your daily meditations (Psalm 19.14)
